- (b) In case the candidate is claiming the seat reserved for DSC/DST/DOBC (wherever applicable) category then He/ She should have passed his/ her qualifying exam from Delhi School/College and must have SC/ST/OBC certificate issued by the Competent Authority of Govt. of NCT of Delhi only.

- (b) The candidates are required to check their status of Enrolment for Centralized Online Counselling Process and confirmation of payment of the Fee on the website (https://ipu.admissions.nic.in) and must take the printout of online fee confirmation receipt with the transaction details, to be retained for all future reference.
- (c) Candidates are advised in their own interest to complete the process of fee submission online much before the closing date and not to wait till the last minute to avoid transaction failure or any other technical fault due to congestion on web server on account of heavy load on internet/website.
- (d) If the fee is paid through credit/debit card and status is not 'OK', it means the transaction got cancelled and the amount will be refunded to concerned credit/debit card. Such candidates have to pay the fee once again. The candidates are required to check their status of payment of the Fee on the website (https://ipu.admissions.nic.in) and must take the printout of online fee confirmation receipt with the transaction details, to be retained for all future reference.
